2010 KOICHI/TOYO NERIO SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM
INFORMATION SHEET

The Koichi/Toyo Nerio Scholarship was established in 2004 with the fund donated to the Southeast Japanese School and Community Center by the Koichi/Toyo Nerio Charitable Remainder Unitrust. The scholarships will be awarded every year to qualified graduating high school seniors who have academic, cultural and athletic potentials for the purpose of encouraging them to achieve excellence in higher education. A candidate must meet the following eligibility requirements to apply for the scholarship.

A. Eligibility Requirements:

1. Must be a graduating high school senior and plans to enroll in college this year.
2. Must be a son or daughter whose parents are currently a due-paying member of the club/ organization affiliated with the Community Center and have paid membership dues at least for three years in prior period.
3. A child of the family who used to be a member but is currently inactive may also apply if the parents have paid membership dues at least for three years in prior period.
4. A person is also eligible to apply if he/she is currently participating in the Community Center activities for which the organization's activities are scheduled on a seasonal program basis and has additionally participated in the entire previous two periods for a total of three seasons and has fully paid membership dues for the current /past three seasons.
5. The provisions for Items 2, 3 and 4 above can be combined to meet the required minimum three year period of membership dues payment. However, the participation periods of each category must be clearly delineated on the application form and the records of payment must be substantiated by responsible club officials in each category..
6. The above qualifying records of membership due payment must be verified and validated by the club/organization to which the applicant belongs.

B. Application Procedures:

1. To obtain the Scholarship Application Form, ask the representative of your organization for a copy of the Application Form or you may download a copy of the application form from Community Center website: www.SEJSCC.org
2. It is important that all items (Items A, B, C and D) on the application form are completed in full as each item is given certain points for evaluation. If more space is needed, attach additional sheets.
3. Take the completed Application Form and this Information Sheet to the representative of the organization to which you/your parents belong, ask him/her to verify the information you noted in the Community Center Membership Information section of the Application Form and, if verified, have him/her sign his/her name certifying that you meet the membership due payment requirement.
4. Obtain (a) a school transcript covering the 9th, 10th, 11th and the first semester of the 12th grades and (b) an official record of your SAT scores, and attach them to the Application Form.
5. Mail your completed Application Form, together with all required additional documents, to SEJSCC, 14615 Gridley Road, Norwalk, CA 90651. It must be received by the deadline date of **March 19**. Hand-delivery to the Community Center building will not be accepted and will be rejected. It must be mailed through the US post office system. An application packet to the Southeast Japanese School and Community Center post-marked on the due-date is acceptable.
6. If you are selected, you must attend the award presentation ceremony to receive your scholarship award in person. **There will be no exception to the mandatory attendance requirement.** The presentation ceremony this year is scheduled for Saturday April 17, 2010.
