2022 KOICHI/TOYO NERIO SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM
INFORMATION SHEET

The Koichi/Toyo Nerio Scholarship was established in 2004 with funds donated to the Southeast Japanese School and Community Center by the Koichi/Toyo Nerio Charitable Remainder Unitrust. The annual scholarship provides a onetime monetary award to qualified graduating high school seniors seeking higher education. A candidate must meet the following requirements to apply for the scholarship.

A. Eligibility Requirements:

1. Must be a graduating high school senior planning to enroll in college this year.
2. Must be an active SEJSCC member for at least **three years** in any previous time period, including one year in high school.
3. The membership period must be clearly stated on the application form and the records of membership must be verified and validated by an executive club officer from a SEJSCC club/organization.

B. Application Procedures:

1. To obtain the Scholarship Application Form, download a copy of the application form from the Community Center website: www.sejscc.org. (Please download and type on the form.)
2. It is important that all items on the application form are completed in full. If more space is needed, attach additional sheets.
3. Take the completed Application Form and this Information Sheet to an officer of the organization (non-family member), to which you belong, to verify the information in section F of this form.
4. Attach a school transcript covering the 9th, 10th, and 11th grades and first semester of 12th grade to the Application Form.
5. Send your completed Application Form via email attachment or Google drive, together with all required additional documents, to gakuen@sejscc.org. Deadline for submission is **February 12, 2022**. You will receive an e-mail confirmation.
6. If you are selected, please attend the awards presentation ceremony to receive your scholarship award in person. The presentation ceremony is scheduled for **Saturday, April 9, 2022. Please RSVP by March 26, 2022.**
