T-Shirt Design Contest Rules 2024

- 1. **Eligibility:**
- The contest is open to all current Center participants of the Southeast Japanese School and Community Center.
- 2. **Theme:**
- Create original artwork that captures the essence and significance of the **Southeast Japanese School and Community Center's century-long journey.**
- 3. **Submission Guidelines:**
 - Each participant may submit only one design.
 - Designs must be submitted in high-resolution JPEG or PNG.
 - Optional: Include a brief description or inspiration behind the design.
 - Your artwork must be submitted to tomodachi.sejscc@gmail.com and label the file as follows, FIRST NAME LAST NAME
 - Include your full name, group affiliation, phone number, email address, and home address in the body of the email.
- 4. **Originality:**
 - Designs must be original and should not infringe on any third-party copyrights or trademarks. Plagiarism or the use of copyrighted material without permission will result in disqualification.
- 5. **Technical Specifications:**
- Designs should be suitable for printing on the back of a T-shirt and may include up to three colors. The design should be no larger than 12 inches wide and 14 inches tall.
 - The SEJSCC Board reserves the right to make adjustments to coloring and size.
- 6. **Submission Deadline:**
 - All entries must be submitted by April 30, 2024.
 - Late entries will not be considered.
- 7. **Selection Process:**
 - Designs will be judged based on creativity, relevance to the theme, and visual appeal.
 - The judging panel will consist of the Board of Directors.
- 8. **Prizes:**
- The winner of the T-shirt design contest will win a t-shirt with their design printed on it along with \$100.
 - Prizes are non-transferable and may not be redeemed for cash.
- 9. **Announcement of Winners:**
 - Winners will be announced prior to the Festival, June 2024.

10. **Rights and Permissions:**

- By submitting a design, participants grant the SEJSCC the right to use, modify, and reproduce the design for promotional purposes, including on T-shirts and related merchandise.

11. **Disqualification:**

-The SEJSCC reserves the right to disqualify any entry that violates the contest rules or fails to meet the specified criteria.

12. **Modification of Rules:**

- The SEJSCC reserves the right to modify or cancel the contest at any time, and participants will be notified of any changes.
